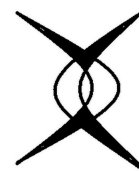

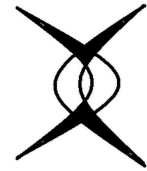

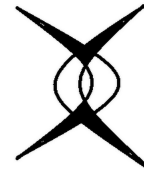
(2) Restrictions on use and supply
